- 2. Download the form to your computer
- 3. If this form is completed on your computer, you will need to
  - i) enter the details
  - ii) save the completed form

- 4. If you want to complete the form with either pen or biro, you will need to
  - i) Print the form
  - ii) Complete the form using BLOCK CAPITALS only should you require any extra space, please add a separate piece of paper and put the rest of the detail on that, referencing the particular section heading (Note paper applications that are not completed in block capitals will automatically be rejected)
